COMMUNITY MEAL OUTREACH CELEBRATES ONE YEAR OF MINISTRY

1,260 Meals Served in 2007

The Community Meal Ministry will be celebrating its 1st Anniversary in just a few weeks. Our first meal was served on Saturday, February 17, 2007. We continued serving one meal a month through April and went to two meals monthly during the month of May. That's 21 meals, served to approximately 1,260 people. We cooked everything from pizza and salad to turkey and stuffing with all the fixin's, from stone soup to hotdogs and corn on the cob. Our guests ate in the church dining room and out in the yard under the tent. We gave them gloves, coats, scarves, shampoo, toothpaste, groceries, cookies, candy, a hot meal, and a smile from every person they met here. No two meals were alike but every Saturday became an opportunity to share God's love and God's Word.

As we begin this new year, we want to thank

everyone who has donated their time and resources to make this ministry a success. God has truly blessed your efforts and we are looking forward to a new year and new opportunities to share God's love and abundance with our community. If you come and work with us on a regular basis—thank you! If you haven't yet been able to join us, make it a priority this year—you won't be sorry.

2008 CONGREGATIONAL MEETING HELD

Budget Approved/Additional Leaders Confirmed

Following Worship II on Sunday January 27, Bob Seaver, Church Administrator and Board Chairman led the Annual Congregational Meeting. Primary agenda items included the presentation and approval of the 2008 Budget and the approval of additional Church leaders. A report concerning the improvements to our facilities was also given.

The 2008 Budget totals just over \$373,000.00. The financial report for 2007 showed a an income of \$365,575.96 and a surplus in giving over expenses of \$11,962.24. Giving at NSCC has increased each year. We anticipate another year of God's faithful provision through His people. In addition to all Church expenses being met in 2007, \$138,088.58 was distributed to local, domestic and foreign missions! The Missions Department gladly serves as a channel of blessing for the advancement of the Gospel throughout the world.

Nineteen new leaders were approved at the meeting. Joining Carl Divers and Daryl Tait as Trustee is Roger Salvatora. Sherry Singer will again serve as our Librarian. New Deaconesses are: Joan Cole, Deb Croup, Megan Duffield, Joanne Duncan, Lacy Eckert, Michelle Grooms, Kathi Huber, and Dale Riemer. A WORD FROM PASTOR BOB

AMAZED! That is the word that describes best my reaction to the ins-and-outs and the ups-and-downs of the spiritual journey of North Street Christian Church. This past year, has been another adventurous year of walking with our Lord and it has produced some wonderful stories of our journey with Him.

A Ministry Plan/People/Prayer/Facilities/Funds – these are the four influencing factors of our ongoing ministry here at North Street Church. Our MINISTRY PLAN of course comes from God through His Word. The Great Commission tells us to GO, to MAKE DISCIPLES, to BAPTIZE them and to TEACH THEM TO OBEY His every command. The marching orders of the Church have not changed. It is the consistent PRAYER covering and under-girding that enables any area of ministry success. As we go forth, we need your prayer support.

The Ministry Plan is fulfilled through **PEO-PLE** – people who worship and pray and give and go - people who lead and people who follow - people who cry and care and laugh and encourage and admonish and teach and preach - people who lead peo-

ple to the cross of Christ - people who quietly serve with no title or notice. He created all of us to be used as one body for His glory. Praise God for people who are motivated by His love and Spirit.

It is fulfilled through people and FACILI-TIES. In a Church like ours, the building is a primary tool to fulfill the plan. Ours is old and some of it is old and tired. BUT the production it enables makes it worth some further investment. A new roof over the Christian Education Annex is underway, the house at 209 Bluff Street has been purchased, the former parsonage at 232 West North is being converted into a ministry house - Legacy. Plans to remodel the interior of the Christian Ed Annex are next on the list along with a Master Site Plan for future expansion of our facilities.

The plan is fulfilled through people and facilities and **FUNDS**. The giving at NSCC is up and showing greater potential as each year passes. In 2007, the income surpassed the budget by \$11.000.00. The missions department


had nearly \$12,000.00 at year-end to distribute in addition to the monthly support that was given. A total of nearly \$140,000 was given through the Missions Department in 2007! Of course expenses are up too. Let each one of us lay by in store as God has prospered and when we do – amazing things will continue to happen. Let us be diligent, living by faith, trusting Him for each tomorrow. Expect a Building Campaign soon. We are committed to remain debt free and will build in phases as the funds come in.

I have no big congregational predictions for 2008. On a personal level – I plan to play a lot more offense this year and desire to speak life into others plans for ministry. It is fun watching the Lord's will unfold. Proverbs 16:9 says, "In his heart a man plans his course, but the LORD determines his steps." Let it be!
