REVIVE US AGAIN and AGAIN and AGAIN!?!

Are you in need of revival? Again, so soon? How often SHOULD God's people need revived? How often DO God's people need revived?

I have often asked those kinds of questions of myself. Sometimes I would think that I go to God too often for spiritual vitality. But then I think that is exactly what God wants us to do – isn't it - to be totally dependent on Him for EVERYTHING—ALL OF THE TIME?

I think of the manna of the wilderness – that perfect food which sustained the Israelite wanderers for 40 years – it came every morning. And if it was hoarded it rotted – was of no value the next day. It took a daily re-supply!

I think of the model for prayer as given by Jesus. He said "Give us THIS DAY our DAILY BREAD. We are taught a daily dependence upon God for each day's perfect supply! I think of Jesus' teaching concerning our troubles. He taught us to seek God and His righteousness and that the things for daily living would be provided by God – just as He provides for the flowers of the field and the birds of the air. He taught that each day has enough trouble of its own. That means that we should not carry yesterday or tomorrow into today but that we should depend on God for all things every day!

The best answer I have to the question "How often do God's people need revived?" is - "As often as they lose their vive." That is - their "life" - their vitality - their spirited living in the Lord. Revival is for God's people who have drifted spiritually - no matter how often and how quickly they drift!

Leonard Ravenhill said, "As long as we are content to live without revival, we will."

Do you desire an increased love for God, a

new awareness of sin and its consequences and a renewed hunger for His Word? SEEK GOD allowing Him to plow up the fallow ground in your life.

So far as I can tell – I need revived EVE-RYDAY. I confess my daily need for and dependence on God. Stephen Olford teaches that in revival God visits His own people – restoring, reanimating, and releasing them into the fullness of His blessing.
