

Volunteers from various local churches serve the Lord together at LOLCO. All of our food and meals are donated by individuals and local churches. Presently we are in need of re-stocking our shelves in order to help with the ongoing needs. Donations can be brought to NSCC on Sundays and placed in the large bins at each doorway or can be dropped off during the week at the NSCC LOLCO at 232 West North Street. **Needed Items are**: (#10 cans or the bigger family sized cans are preferred) spaghetti sauce, marinara sauce, pizza sauce, vegetables, applesauce, pudding, fruit, cream soups, canned tuna, canned chicken, noodles, pasta. In addition, the following meats are used often and presently needed: hot dogs, ground meat, ham, pre-cooked meatballs.
