The Original Jesus Movement

A Primer of the Book of Acts

The NSCC go-to book of the Bible in 2019 is the Book of Acts. NSCC Community Meal Ministry

One of our local mission outreaches happens right here at NSCC on the second and third Saturday of each month. A crew of *happy campers* get together to prepare and serve a meal to anyone who wants to come and eat with us. We call it a COMMUNITY MEAL and we normally serve 55 – 75 people or more each month. The meal is served at 5:00. Helpers arrive about 3:00. The only qualification to come and help is that you show up with a *happitude* and want to serve Jesus by serving others! Jesus said – "I tell you the truth, whatever you did for one of the least of these brothers of mine, you did for me." Come and serve the Lord with us! The March meals will be served on the 9th and the 16th.

SHEPHERD OF MY HEART PRESCHOOL SPAGHETTI DINNER

One of the great ministries we have here at NSCC is the **Shepherd of My Heart Christian Preschool**. We have a M-W-F Bible-based Christian Education program for Pre-K kids and on T-TH we have a similar program for pre-schoolers. We presently minister to over 20 families and our enrollment is typically full with a waiting list.

This ministry employs one teacher and three helpers. They are Fi Saeler, Debbie Moyer, Tina Rader and Brandi Garbinski. Our Preschool Board includes Chairwoman Kathy Twerdok and Board Members Barb Carson, Marlene Winters, Tina Rader and Kasey Gaiser. Pastor Bob serves as the school Principal and also sits on the board. NSCC provides the space and utilities and some additional costs for the expenses of the preschool.

The funding of Shepherd of My Heart Christian Preschool is generated from three sources – tuition, donations and fundraising. Tuition produces 85% - 90% of the funds needed to meet the annual expenses. Donations are received from time to time but are not solicited through any ongoing effort. Fundraising efforts typically provide \$2,500 - \$4,500 per year for the school. A new fundraiser is announced below – and WE CAN USE YOUR HELP!

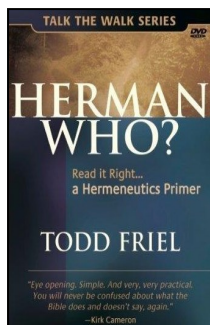

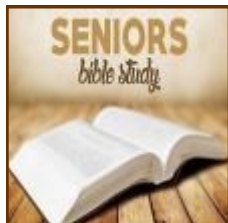

KIDS CLUB

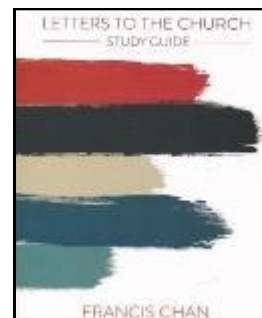
