

MEN OF HONOR STUDY GROUPS COMING SOON! Begins Monday, September 17th and Saturday, September 22nd

The studies in the **Men of Honor** course are focused and intentional. The purpose is to help men to become **Men of Honor** by "cleansing themselves" from all impurity. (2 Timothy 2:21: Therefore if anyone cleanses himself from the latter, he will be a vessel for honor, sanctified and useful for the Master, prepared for every good work.) The Bible is the textbook, the heart is the target, and the Holy Spirit is the Teacher.

The studies are to help men to find freedom from any impurity, thereby becoming **Men of Honor**. It is important to understand that there are many different habitual sins from which we are required to be cleansed. Men struggle with pornography and sexual impurity of all kinds, with overeating and overdrinking, with drug abuse, gambling, smoking, and all kinds of other habitual sins. There are also heart sins which need to be addressed. Issues such as sinful anger, bitterness, deceit, covetousness, etc., are sins which are not always easily seen, but may destroy Christian life and inhibit fruitfulness. Through the **Men of Honor** course, these sins will all be addressed, and men will be invited to turn from them, and to turn to Christ.
