Might You Have A Case of "I-itis"?

We are all susceptible to it and it seems to come and go in many of our lives – ever get a case of *I-ITIS*? Technically, *I-it is* is an *inflammation* of self! For some there is not much hope as they seem to have case of *Chronic I-itis*, but for others it appears to be *Acute I-itis* which may be cured. Even so, there is the possibility of it having to be treated more than once in a lifetime.

We just may have a case of it, when like Moses, being called upon by God to carry out a task in His Name, began to make excuse saying, BUT who am "I" that . . . Moses looked to his own resources and forgot that when God calls us to perform for Him that He also provides the resources! (Exodus 3) Moses had a case of "AMNESIATIC I-ITIS"! He thought it was all about himself and forgot that it was all about God.

We just may have a case of it, when like Elijah (as he battled with the prophets of Baal thought he was the only faithful one left in all of Israel) think that we are the only one left to do the

work of God! Several times in I Kings 19, Elijah says, "I" alone am left." He had his eyes too much on self and not enough on God. (Interestingly, the Lord had just given deliverance over 450 prophets of Baal, yet Elijah was on the run from one wicked woman named Jezebel!) When our eyes are too much on self and not enough on God, we too end up in self-pity and depression and go on the run. When that happens - it's a sure case of "I-itis!" Elijah had a case of "COMPARATIVE I-ITIS"!

We just may have a case of it when like Peter, who declared "Even if all (all of the other disciples) are made to stumble because of You, "I" will never be made to stumble." (Matthew 26:33) think that we are just a little more committed that everyone else. Peter who certainly loved his peers and was a great leader at times here displayed a case of "SUPERIOR I-ITIS" As we know, he quickly thereafter three times denied that he even knew

Jesus! Watch out when you think that you're "in" with God in a way that others are not.

No matter how you diagnose it, the root of *I-itis* is selfish pride. Whether it is approaching a God assignment with fear or believing that YOU are the remaining truth courier or believing that YOU are more committed than anyone else – Pride is the root!

To be PROUD – means boastful, high-minded, arrogant, vainglory, haughty, to appear over

To be HUMBLE – means low lying, brought low, a low degree, of a low estate, cast down

Get lower not higher!
