LIVING IN ISOLATION OR ONENESS?

Building Strong Marriages

By observation, would you agree that many marriages end up in ISOLATION? That is the state where a husband and wife share the same anniversary date, the same last name, the same address, the same kids and the same checkbook but live separate lives! Rather than working together as one, they are like two trains running on parallel tracks.

God's plan is quite different. He describes the state of marriage according to His plan as ONENESS. That is where a husband and wife are knit together as one in every way. By God's design, a husband and wife are to experience oneness spiritually, physically and emotionally.

Most would look to marriage and agree to do their part so long as their mate does his/her part. When a marriage becomes a 50/50 proposition, acceptance is based on performance. Affection is based on the "grade" you get. Motivation for action is based on *how you feel* rather than what is right.

In the 50/50 plan, you will never be able to know for sure if your mate has met you ½ way. You will focus on your mate's weaknesses instead of his/her strengths. Your disappointment will paralyze your own performance and the downward spiral will continue.

No matter what the plan for a successful marriage would be; if it is not the God's plan for oneness, it will end up in isolation. Christian marriage is not a 50/50 proposition it is a 100/100 covenant! In Christian marriage each partner performs 100% to glory of God, no matter their mate's performance.

Want to build a stronger marriage?

First, get your eyes off of your own desires and off of your mate's weaknesses Then, both of you get your eyes on Jesus Christ. He is the center of every Christian marriage and when both husband and wife live to please Him first, they suddenly find themselves cleaving to one another in the oneness that God intends. Making Jesus the center of your marriage really works!
