

Are Atheists Hijacking Academic Freedom? (As Excerpted from "The Expelled Chronicle")

The theory of intelligent design holds that certain features of the universe and of living things are best explained by an intelligent cause rather than an undirected process such as natural selection. Intelligent Design is thus a scientific disagreement with the core claim of evolutionary theory that the apparent design of living systems is an illusion.

The upcoming film **EXPELLED**: No Intelligence Allowed starring Ben Stein articulates why the argument made in the film is irrefutable - meaning that those who oppose "Intelligent Design" theory as a valid topic in the science classroom are simply wrong to oppose it.

The whole point of man's thirst for knowledge, scientific and otherwise, is to answer the question "Who are we?" "Where did we come from?" "Why are we here?" and "Where are we headed?" To deny this is to



questions is either wrong or intellectually disingenuous. The official definition of science currently holds that it is "the study of observable natural phenomenon that excludes those explanations citing the "supernatural." This definition is disingenuous - it all but "defines" science as the search for "proof" of exclusively atheistic theories.

Highly credentialed "dissenters" from today's prevailing "materialist" theories of life's progression who wish to pursue science on the basis of a presupposition of intelligent design are being persecuted, vilified, denied tenure and even fired from their jobs for their beliefs today. To even question aspects of Darwin's theory of evolution is being used as prima facie evidence that one is "unintelligent," and/or unqualified.
