



Spiritual Leadership and Prayer

2008 National Day of Prayer is Thursday, May 1

We are people who reach people in the name of Jesus. We all have experienced times when we have felt mightily used of the Lord and other times when we have felt that we just don't have much spiritual power in our going forth, in our words and in our ministry. Sometimes the *spiritual oomph* just isn't there like it is at other times.

E.M. Bounds states that much prayer is the price of unction. He defines unction as the anointing of the Holy Ghost, separating unto God's work and qualifying for it. Without prayer we go forth as any other good speaker, salesman or politician. We have words to share and carry something with us that we believe others need but without the unction of the Spirit, which is found in much preparation through prayer, we have no real spiritual power.

John Wesley said, "Give me one hundred preachers who fear nothing but sin and desire nothing but God, and I care not a straw whether they be clergymen or laymen; such alone will shake the gates of hell and set up the kingdom of heaven on earth. God does nothing but in answer to prayer."

The Apostles gave themselves continually to prayer and the ministry of the Word. Paul declared that it was by night and day that he and those with him prayed exceedingly. This kind of praying is taxing, toilsome and imperative. (Bounds) Just as with the Apostles, our words and ministry will carry no power for life-change until it is all bathed supplications, petitions and intercessions.

Acts 17:27,28 the Bible says, "God did this so that men would seek him and perhaps reach out for him and find him, though he is not far from each one of us. 'For in Him we live and MOVE and have our being..."

The gospel is the most important thing we can know. It is what Paul preached "as of first importance" in 1 Corinthians 15. It gives us hope in that God took action while we were dead in our trespasses and sins. We were helpless, hopeless and separated from God, but God did not leave us there. In love He has moved. The gospel is the story about God coming near through Jesus Christ. It is because of this action—the life of Jesus—that we can enter God's presence, draw near to Him, and encourage others to do the same. God is the first to MOVE...and because He has, we can.

In 2008, over 30,000 students (going into 9th grade through 2008 graduated seniors) on 5 different continents will follow His lead and MOVE. There are over 24 five-day events being held all over the nation. Through MOVE tens of thousands of high school students will be called to live for the sake of the gospel. The goal is to part of God raising up 250,000 students who will stand for Christ. Students will be challenged to reach out in their community for the sake of the gospel, to choose where they will work and what they do for the sake of the gospel. They will learn to look NOW for opportunities to serve locally and globally for the sake of the gospel. Our hope is that students will look at their homes, high schools, and even where they go to college with the gospel in mind.
