#### Ollie, Ollie In Free

Sunday mornings are a wonderful event for me. Gathering together with my Christian family is an assuring, energizing and encouraging thing. It is good to be amongst the fellowship of believers who like myself build their lives upon faith in and the serving of our God. In a way, the Sunday gathering it is like touching base in a game - it says, "We made it out and back." It says, "SAFE!" It says, "Ollie, Ollie in free!" (which is probably actually "All in, All in for free" - to signal that the game is over - for now!) It is a reminder that we may all be out there doing "our own thing" all week long but that we do belong to one another and that we are really on the same team when it is over and done with. We then huddle up and get some instruction and go at it again.

It doesn't take very long after the Sunday gathering to get out there facing the struggles of everyday life and seemingly all alone to feel somewhat abandoned and wondering how we will make it until the next huddle. There are times we may even wonder, "Is anybody else facing what I am

facing? Does anybody even care?"

I want to recall a scene from II Kings 6. Elisha, God's prophet is being pursued by Ben-Hadad the King of Syria who had been raiding one Israelite town after another. Elisha knew the Syrian plans through God's supernatural revelation and would inform the Israelites what was about to happen next. Ben-Hadad's plans were foiled one too many times and he was ticked. He was out to get Elisha once and for all so he sent horses and chariots and a great army - to get this one man! They surrounded the whole city of Dothan at night! Elisha's servant got up early, went outside and got an eyeful of the Syrian army and reported back to Elisha with fear saying, "What shall we do?" Elisha responded that God was greater and that those with the two of them were greater than all the Syrians put together. And then Elisha prayed that the servant could see what he saw! They both saw a mountain load of horses and chariots and fire! It was God's heavenly host. They were there all

the time – but not always visible! God does not forsake or abandon us when we think that we are alone and that the enemy is stronger. God's heavenly host exists and is at work for His glory, His righteousness and His people – even today and even for US!

Here are some verses to help you remember that even when we are not together that God is still with US!

Hebrews 12:22 – . . . You have come to an innumerable company of angels! Psalms 34:7 – The angel of the LORD encamps around those who fear Him, and He delivers them.

Psalms 91:11– For He will command His angels concerning you to guard you in all your ways. . .

Always looking forward to getting together with you, but knowing that God is still with me and with you when we are apart!
