During those months, over 800 of these precious people gave their hearts to the Lord! Just when the Church should have been unable – through God, the Church was more able than ever! Get Ready for THE TRUTH PROJECT Small Groups Study In 2009/Leaders Needed NOW!

Have you ever thought about your WORLDVIEW? You might respond by saying, "I didn't even know I had one!" You do have one! We all do. A worldview is simply – how we see, understand, explain the world. A person's worldview consists of the values, ideas or the fundamental belief system that determines his attitudes, beliefs and ultimately, actions. Typically, this includes his view of issues such as the nature of God, man, the meaning of life, nature, death, and right and wrong. (T. Munsil) "Oh" you might be saying – "I guess I do have one!"

Here are seven questions which are common to many worldview resources and provide an effective tool for adults, as well as teenagers, particularly to evaluate the worldview of books, music and movies:

- 1. Is there a god and what is he like?
- 2. What is the nature and origin of the universe?
- 3. What is the nature and origin of man?4. What happens to man after death?
- 5. Where does knowledge come from?
- 6. What is the basis of ethics and morality?
- 7. What is the meaning of human history?
