### CONGREGATIONAL MEETING FOLLOWING WORSHIP II TODAY Building Plans To Be Announced

Following Worship II today, there will be a Congregational Meeting held to present plans for remodeling and future expansion of our Church building. The Building and Grounds Department will present and explain the architectural conceptual drawings as completed by Ligo Architects of Slippery Rock, Pa.

Phase I will be to remodel the Sunday School annex and west wing of the existing building. This would include the addition of a large classroom for Jr. High Ministry and the expansion of several other classrooms including updated heating and air-conditioning. An elevator, several new restrooms and new kitchen design is also be included in this phase.

Phase II will be to build an addition to the west side of the front of the main building

which would include a new entrance and greeting area along with new offices and restrooms. In addition, parking and landscaping projects would be completed. (Eventually a third phase would complete our campus with the addition of new, large multi-purpose fellowship building.)

The first congregational meeting will be held today. On Sunday the 21st, the Building and Grounds Department members will be available for Q and A during the Sunday School Hour and following Worship II. A second congregational meeting will be held on Sunday September 28th for congregational approval to begin a Capital Campaign to raise funds for the Phase I remodeling. The project will advance as funds are received. NSCC intends to remain debt free.

#### THE SILVER RING THING

This Saturday, September 20th At Knoch High School

The Silver Ring Thing (SRT), the fastest growing teen abstinence program in the United States will be at Knoch High School this Saturday, September 20th from 6:30-9:00 p.m. Youth planning to attend will meet at Legacy House at 5:45 p.m.

THE LIVE EVENT SRT's 2-2.5 hour stage performance incorporates high energy music, special effects, fast-paced video, personal testimonies, and comedy all delivered in a concert-style approach with which teenagers can respond and relate. The program also presents an evangelistic message focused on forgiveness and new beginnings with an opportunity to embrace a "second virginity." Students who make a commitment to abstinence may purchase a silver ring as a symbol and reminder of their decision. After each event, students who make this commitment are followed-up by SRT staff with weekly emails that encourage and equip these students in their commitment. This event is targeted at middle/high school students (ages 12-18) but is also relevant to college and young adult ages. A parent's session is also held at each event to educate parents about what is happening in today's youth culture and how they can encourage and support their child's abstinence commitment.

A sign-up sheet is at Legacy House. Admission will be paid by the Parent Council for Legacy youth and a guest, if they wish to bring one.
