Are there thoughts of wonder, tinges of fear, amazement or thankfulness or concern for what you hear?


Do you sometimes dream?...

Meet the Mitchells! Russ and Cathy have served the Lord in Romania through One Challenge (OC) since 1997. Their children Abby, James, Jon and David join them in the quest to bring the word of God and the assurance of salvation to the people of that country and beyond. The vision of OC is for healthy churches to work together to reach all nations. NSCC supports that vision through the Mitchell family. The mission of OC is to

mobilize Godly and effective church leaders to reach all nations. Russ has served in various capacities while in Romania, being part of and now organizing, training and sending out such leaders. It has been an amazing witness to receive the weekly information from Cathy regarding the spreading of the gospel in Romania and how God has time and time again proven faithful not only in ministry events but in the everyday needs and concerns of the Mitchell family. We have prayed fervently for the ministry and the family and your prayers have been effective. From the provision of their van registration to housing for ministry students, to appropriate educational supports for the children, God continues to provide. Most recently there has been a ministry partnership formed, providing yet another couple to teach the missionary course to nationals and support church growth; there is a translation of the book "Gods Heart for the Nations" in progress; a new partnership with a church in Canada; continued 'food' for the pastors newsletter that Russ puts out; and a growing interest in promoting missions within the country in order to address breaking the barrier of only 1% Christian population. The family asks for your prayer in all of these matters as well as for continued improvement in the children's education, plans for the International Leadership Team Conference in October that they are hosting and the small group study that is planned in their home beginning in October. May we be mindful of those who serve in places that we can only glimpse in letters, in news and in prayerful hope of nations united by our love for and service to our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. 
