Her friend, Kyle, drove her to the airport leaving here at 2:37 a.m. today. Please continue to pray for Christina. Her tentative schedule loosely given is:

Week 1: Christina will live at the Hogar Miguel Orphanage outside the city of Antigua and minister to the kids while serving at the facility.

Week 2 and 3: Christina will stay at the Candelaria hotel in Antigua and travel to the mission sites to translate for American Doctors treating the villagers. She will also help fit children with new outfits and shoes courtesy of the donations of several of our dear friends (THANKS!) and the generosity of the other mission workers from the US.

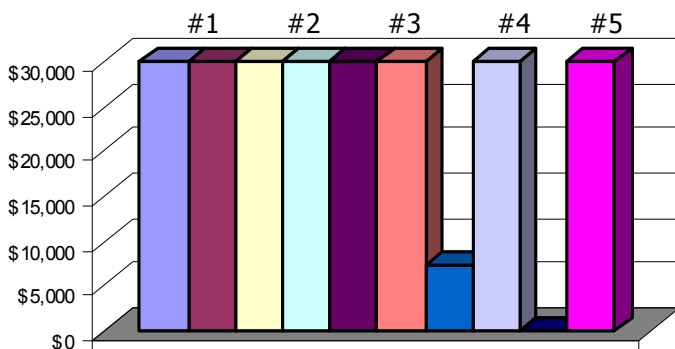
