Teen Missions in Belize is located near Orange Walk Town. It was founded in 2005 and is one of the newest bases in the world-wide ministry of Teen Missions. When first purchased, the property was a mass of jungle, but has since been developed into a beautiful base. The first and only "Mission Camp" (youth training program similar to The Lord's Boot Camp) was run in 2006. Since then the staff have been working to promote Teen Missions and gain the trust of the Belizean people.

You are invited to an evening of food and fellowship this Wednesday, May 20th at 6:30 p.m. at Legacy. Come and hear what the Lord is doing in the Houtens' lives and their work in Belize. A Belizian meal will be prepared by the Houtens and the youth. Be encouraged about how the Lord uses just ordinary people.

If someone asked me to describe NORTH STREET CHRISTIAN CHURCH after having worked amongst this congregation for nearly 30 years, I would say something like this, "North Street Christian Church is an amazing congregation of dedicated people. Historically the people have done "more than they are able" when it comes to ministry outreach and giving to the needs and causes of others. Even when we have been dealing with other issues that may have threatened our stability, somehow we have maintained a spirit of love and made progress toward the goals to which God has called us. This Church has consistently amazed me."

We have taken a group of 19 people to Romania to dry-wall a medical clinic. We have gone to Thailand on several occasions to encourage the Christians in Chiang Mai and in the Hill Tribe Villages. We have given funds to build several Church Buildings there and have had the privilege of dedicating at least two of them. There are two more underway right now! We have built 5 houses in Mexico with Casas Por Cristo. We have remodeled Legacy. We have helped one another with moving, putting on roofs, repairing cars, digging ditches, dry walling, pouring concrete, building retaining walls, painting, installation of doors and windows etc. etc. etc.

NOW is the time for every man and woman and boy and girl who has a **mind to work** to volunteer to help us in the various stages of the remodeling of yellow brick education building and dining room. We can use lots of help throughout the summer. It all begins the week of June 1 when we


BAKED GOODS NEEDED FOR MEALS ON WHEELS
