Hell Is Too Long To Be Wrong

What is the most tragic thing you can think of? A person heading for hell is tragic, but what about a person who knows this but doesn't care? Even

more tragic than this is someone thinking they are heading for heaven, but will hear the words of Christ, "Depart from me, I never knew you." (Matthew 7:23) Such a life is lived with the sad epilogue that they lived a life self-deceived. And according to Jesus, this isn't only possible, but it is reality - especially in the church. It is this self-deception that should be the concern of every single person, the possibility that you aren't saved, but have deceived yourself into thinking you are.

So is it possible to be self-deceived? Yes. But is it also possible to have total assurance of eternal life? Yes! How can you know? LET THE CHURCH RISE BUILDING CAMPAIGN WHY DEBT FREE?

How we use our money is an outward indicator of our spiritual condition.

This is true for individuals and families. It is also true of local Churches. Ministering and living debt-free is not an impossible dream, rather it is God's best and highest way of doing things. Borrowing money is not always sinful, but tt can be risky, wasteful and unwise. The Bible cautions strongly against both borrowing and debt. To borrow and not repay <u>is</u> a sin

J. Hudson Taylor who founded the China Inland Mission and who opened the most heavily populated nation on the earth to the Gospel was highly respected for his faith and insight. He was firmly convicted that God's work, done in God's way would never lack for God's provision. He said the following, "It is really just as easy for God to give beforehand; and He prefers to do so. He is too wise to allow His purpose to be frustrated for lack of a little money; but money wrongly place or obtained in unspiritual ways is sure to hinder blessing. And what does going into debt really mean? It means that God has not sup-

plied your need. You trusted Him, but He has not given you the money; so supply yourself, and borrow. If we can only wait right up to the time, God cannot lie, God cannot forget: He pledged to supply all your need."

Debt-free ministries ranging in size from 100 to 10,000 are found throughout America. When interviewed, the leaders of those ministries testify that it is an exciting, challenging and rewarding adventure to carry out God's enterprise in such fashion. DE-LIGHTED is often the word that best describes the reaction to doing God's business with no debt.

An infectious enthusiasm and creativity results when the goal and determination is to do effective ministry without debt. When people are taught to tithe and give and they do so, all of the resources that God desires to pour out are already provided through not only their finances, but in their gifts, abilities and talents. A new treasure is unlocked that helps people find their place and purpose in ministry. With debt and a worldly philosophy of financing, the people in a Church are typically underchallenged and often not joyfully involved in first-hand ministry.

Too often ministries learn to trust their own innovations and worldly resources rather than doing business with God. Let us seek the Lord with gladness and trust Him for every provision as we give sacrificially to God through the ministry of North Street Christian Church.


