## Today's Message: A Known Commitment

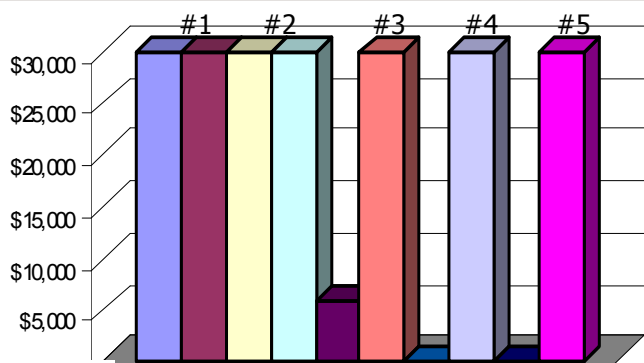
### CONSTRUCTION HAS BEGUN

NSCC Community Meal Report

A mission of NSCC is preparing and serving a meal to the needy in our community. On the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> Saturday of each month, the FREE MEAL TONIGHT sign is put in the church lawn early in the morning. By mid-afternoon, folks show up to prepare the meal and set up the tables and chairs. About 4:40 staff devotions and prayer time are held. At 5:00, prayer is held with the guests and the meal begins and is served until 6:00. During the meal a word from the Word is shared. Several meals are delivered to some of the elderly and needy in the Church. Following the meal, all is cleaned up and put away for the next time. A Christian movie is shown on occasion. On the average, there are between 60 and 90 people who share the meal together. Some are lonely, some are poor, some are hungry, some live alone and just don't feel like cooking – there's lots of ways to describe our guests. We have begun to see them as the Saturday night bunch at NSCC and strive to serve them as we would serve Jesus if He showed up. (And we think He has a time or two!) Matthew 25:40 says *"The King will reply, 'I tell you the truth, whatever you did for one of the least of these brothers of mine, you did for me.'*" And Matthew 25:45 says, *"He will reply, 'I tell you the truth, whatever you did not do for one of the least of these, you did not do for me.'*"
