

The Building and Grounds Department and the Trustees met recently to set in order a list of projects to be completed with our Building Funds. These projects will conclude Phase 1 of our improvements and make way for Phase 2. The projects in order are:

- 1. Demolition of Bluff Street House/back fill/gravel for parking
- 2. Paint and Carpet Interior of Stair Tower
- 3. Remodel Kitchen and purchase new appliances
- 4. Remodel garages beneath pre-school for temporary offices
- 5. Demolish 226 North Street presently used for offices

6. Relocate garage to west end of parking lot/new siding The Church Board approved the projects during the July Board meeting held Tuesday July 20. Projects will be completed as funds are available. As of July 11th, the Building Fund balance was \$10.503.53.
