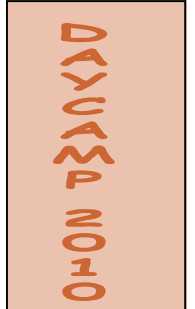
FAREWELL AND GODSPEED TO THE MILLERS

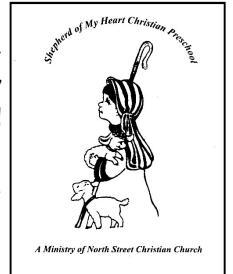
SHEPHERD OF MY HEART—A KID-FRIENDLY PRESCHOOL!
