FRESH WATER - a SPIRITUAL CLEANSING from the Lord. I need it - do you?


FRESH WIND - a FILLING UP TO OVERFLOWING presence of the Holy Spirit in our lives. I need it - do you?

Pastor Jeff Kipp spoke here at NSCC last Easter when he shared the message, Christ in the Passover. On Sunday March 14 he will speak at both the 8:00 and 10:15 Worship gatherings to deliver a message entitled Israel, The Church and the Last Days. During the Sunday School Hour he will share his testimony - What's Nice Jewish Boy Like You Doing in a Church Like This! Get ready to be blessed! Messianic Rabbi Jeff Kipp is the founder of the only two Messianic Congregations in Pittsburgh, Pa. and presently the Rabbi/Pastor of Congregation Yeshua Ben David which meets in the Squirrel Hill. Jeff was the Staff Evangelist for Good News For Israel from 1987 to 1993 as well as the Associate Rabbi of the Seed of Abraham Congregation both based in Minneapolis. Rabbi Jeff and his wife Kathy moved to Pittsburgh in 1993 and pioneered and led Congregation Shoresh David from 1994 to 2004 and in 2005 they planted Congregation Yeshua Ben David. Rabbi Jeff is also a staff evangelist for Chosen People Ministries based in New York City. Rabbi Jeff and his wife Kathy reside in Monroeville, Pa. a suburb of Pittsburgh.
