Christianville Foundation in Gressier, Haiti

The earthquake in Haiti has been most devastating to thousands upon thousands of people. Through connections at Johnson Bible College, Jon Ray found that the Christianville Ministry in Gressier suffered the loss of several buildings. On Thursday the 14th, Pastor Bob was able to speak to a representative of the ministry who lives in Jacksonville Florida and found that all of their buildings have been damaged and





some have been destroyed. An outdoor triage has been set up on the campus of the mission where people are being treated for injuries, including necessary amputations! The mission has two deep wells and supplies the local community with water but both wells presently are producing brown water. Twenty-four US citizens need to be evacuated and some will remain there. Others will be sent once it is clear just what positive action can be taken. Christianville is a Christian mission in Gressier, Haiti, located about 20 miles SW of Port-au-Prince, the capital of Haiti. The main support for Christianville comes from non-denominational churches, mostly Christian Church/Church of Christ churches in the United States. Christianville exists primarily to be a Christian witness to the people of the surrounding communities through evangelism, church planting, medical ministries, and faith-based education. The mission works with six schools, including a Christian university which prepares young men and women for ministry; medical, eye, and dental clinics; numerous churches; a feeding program for children and elderly poor; humanitarian assistance to the community, and more. Our personal finances ended the year better than we had hoped for, with continued concern for this coming year. Russ shared Ephesians 3 with us during prayer time this morning—praise to God who is able to do more than we ask for or imagine!

Yesterday, Russ met with a group from our church who will be each taking a month and leading us in a time of emphasized prayer and giving for that country. He was quite pleased with the synergy that went on during the time together.

The visa for a family with another mission came through! Lidia has been translating some difficult to translate material for Russ/Student Volunteer Movement 2. The SVM2 also is seeking a new coordinator for Romania. Russ is working to set up time with Emilian and his wife, to get to know them better and continue toward admitting them as our first missionaries to go from OC Romania. Josh and Kara Dunckel are transitioning into ministry... their first year of language learning will be foundational to what they do now. 
