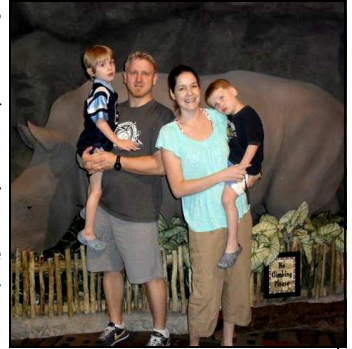

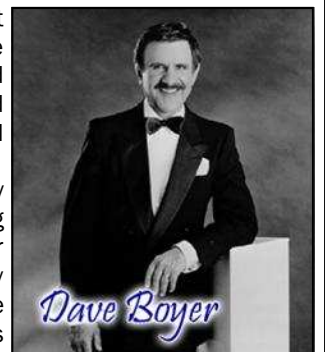
BENEFIT CONCERT TO AID PRESSING ON AND FREEDOM MEETINGS
