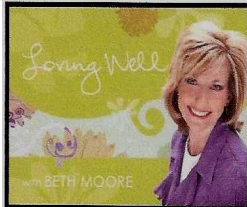

**FIGHT FOR PURITY REPORT**

On Wednesday evenings, Pastor Jeff and Dale Lipan have shared some very truthful and valuable information with men and boys concerning sexual purity. It is amazing just how much the Bible has to say about every subject and this one is no exception. Here is an outline of some things taught this past Wednesday concerning SELF CONTROL – the key to purity! Such great truth applied gives the victory!

**SELF-CONTROL IN SEVEN AREAS**

**1 - THOUGHT control**

**II Corinthians 10:5**—We destroy arguments and every lofty opinion raised against the knowledge of God, and take every thought captive to obey Christ...

**Philippians 4:8**—Finally, brothers, whatever is true, whatever is honorable, whatever is just, whatever is pure, whatever is lovely, whatever is commendable, if there is any excellence, if there is anything worthy of praise, think about these things.

**2 - EYE control**

**Job 31:1**—I have made a covenant with my

eyes; how then could I gaze at a virgin?

**Psalms 101:3**— will not set before my eyes anything that is worthless.

**3 - BODY control**

**I Thessalonians 4:4**—that each one of you know how to control his own body in holiness and honor...

**Romans 6:12**—Let not sin therefore reign in your mortal bodies, to make you obey their passions.

**4 - COMPANION control**

**I Corinthians 15:33**—Do not be deceived: "Bad company ruins good morals."

**Proverbs 5:8**—Keep your way far from her, and do not go near the door of her house...

**5 - CIRCUMSTANCE control**

**Romans 13:14**—But put on the Lord Jesus Christ, and make no provision for the flesh, to gratify its desires.

**II Timothy 2:22**—So flee youthful passions and pursue righteousness, faith, love, and peace, along with those who

call on the Lord from a pure heart.

**6 - INFLUENCE control**

**Proverbs 27:17**—Iron sharpens iron, and one man sharpens another.

**I John 2:15**—Do not love the world or the things in the world. If anyone loves the world, the love of the Father is not in him.

**I Peter 5:8**—Be sober-minded; be watchful. Your adversary the devil prowls around like a roaring lion, seeking someone to devour.


**7 - FOCUS control**

**II Corinthians 5:9**—So whether we are at home or away, we make it our aim to please him.

**I Corinthians 10:31**—So, whether you eat or drink, or whatever you do, do all to the glory of God.

Pastor Jeff taught that remaining pure is unlikely when one or more of these areas are out of control. One class remains—all men and boys are invited to join in—meet this Wednesday at 6:30 in the Dining Room.
