

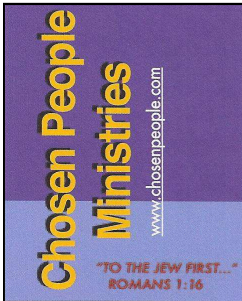

Today's Message: ISRAEL, THE CHURCH, AND THE LAST DAYS by Messianic Rabbi Jeff Kipp



We welcome Rabbi/Pastor Jeff Kipp of Chosen People Ministries to our pulpit today. He will speak on **Israel, The Church and the Last Days**. Last Easter we hosted Pastor Kipp on a Wednesday evening and he shared the message, Christ in the Passover. We gained immense insight concerning the link between Old and New Testament teachings of the Passover Lamb and Jesus Christ, the Lamb of God. Here's a review of today's topic. We will consider the last days prophecies of Ezekiel Chapters 37-39 and discern the times and seasons we are already in. **Jesus in the Feast of Trumpets:** Rosh Hashanah is the Jewish New Year but its original ancient name was called Yom T'ruah, the Day of Blowing the Shofar, the Ram's horn. We will learn how this relevant biblical feast of Israel speaks prophetically to us today of the coming Day of the Lord and Yeshua's 2nd Coming. **Jesus in the Day of Atonement.** Yom Kippur was and is the holiest day of the year for Israel and the Jewish people. We will unpack the depth of the riches of Yeshua's Atonement for us from the Hebrew scriptures and how this Day also speaks prophetically to us of the Lord's 2nd coming and the day when 'all Israel will be saved'. **Jesus in the Feast of Tabernacles.** We will close with a thrilling Word about this ancient prophetic feast of Tabernacles, called Sukkot in the Jewish world or Feast of Booths. Pastor Jeff will unpack for us what this last great feast reveals to us about our present church age and the Messianic Age to come.

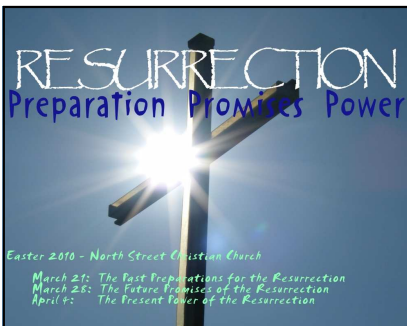

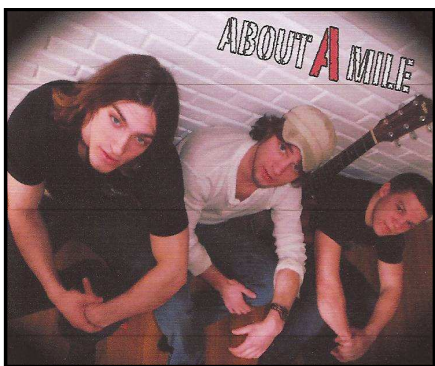
NOTICE OF SPECIAL MEETING TODAY

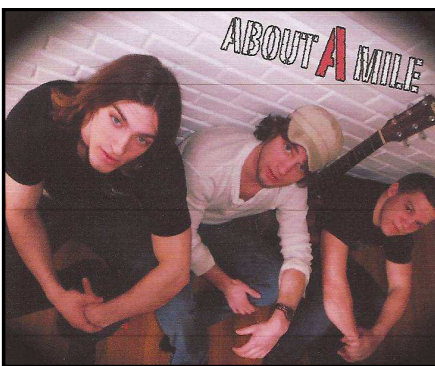

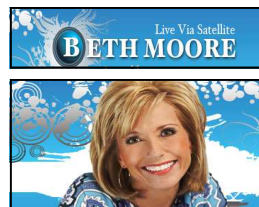

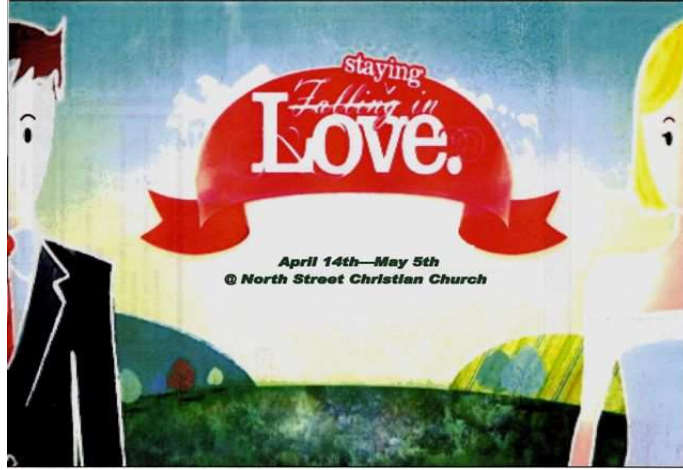
