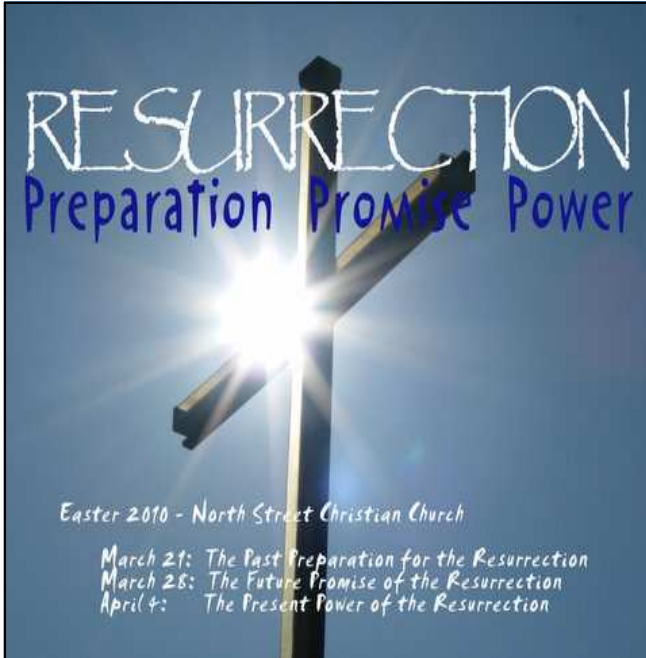

The Easter Sermon Series, Resurrection: Preparation, Promise, Power begins today. Pastor Bob will address the biblical PREPARATION for the resurrection of Jesus Christ. Bodily resurrection from the dead is a theological truth and holds theological consequence. In the Old Testament, three bodily resurrections are recorded. In the New Testament, five named people other than Jesus were raised from the dead in addition to the many who were raised to life at the moment of Jesus death! Today we will learn a little about these incidents and the foundational underpinnings of the vital doctrine of the faith - RESURRECTION!

Next Sunday Pastor Jeff will speak of the PROMISE found in the Resurrection of Jesus Christ. Do you believe that YOU will be resurrected someday? The Bible does make that promise. In fact, ALL will be resurrected - some to eternal life and some to eternal judgment! Come and learn of these future real, bodily resurrections. Because He resurrected - we who believe have the PROMISE of life with HIM!

On Easter Sunday, Pastor Jeff will speak at the 6:45 Sunrise Worship gathering and Pastor Bob will speak at the 10:15 Resurrection Worship gathering. Both will speak of the POWER of the Resurrection of Jesus Christ! The defeat of death at the resurrection of Jesus Christ followed by His ascension back to Heaven has ushered in the Church Age. In this age we find POWER in living in the victory over sin and death and in the personal presence of the Holy Spirit. EASTER is about living in the reality of that LIFE-TRANSFORMING POWER founded in the resurrection of Jesus Christ! Are you living it? "

PIONEER CLUB KIDS LEARN TO SERVE OTHERS

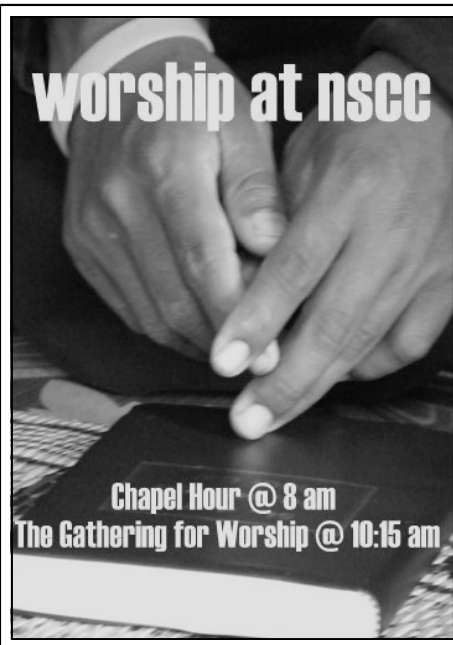
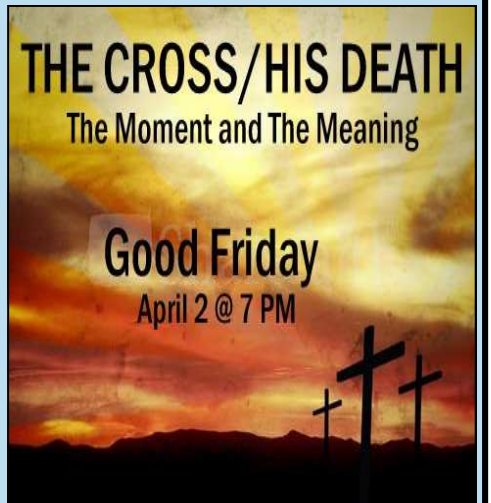

"The Cross/His Death: The Moment and the Meaning" will be the theme on Good Friday evening, April 2, as NSCC gathers for worship at 7:00. The quiet but powerful evening will find believers at worship in song and prayer, in receiving and believing the Word and in sharing the Lord's Supper. We will sing of the power of the blood and the cross of Christ. We will meditate on the moment and meaning of the good event of the death of Jesus Christ. After spending time together we will be sent out to ponder further the wonder and power of His death - the supreme demonstration of His love!



Chapel Hour is designed to be simple and traditional. During this time of worship it is typical to sing traditional hymns led by a worship leader with accompaniment on the piano or keyboard. On occasion a new song or chorus may be sung and other instruments may be used. Chapel Hour is unique in that the preaching is shared by several men of NSCC and either Pastor Bob or Pastor Jeff preaches once a month. Chapel Hour is proving to be a good training place for men who may one day find themselves ready to preach at small churches in our area who need Bible preachers. The Lord Supper is served weekly and the offering is received. Chapel Hour lasts approximately fifty-five minutes. The Pastor's sermon series and small group study themes are not followed in Chapel Hour.

The Gathering for Worship strives to lead worshipers in unpretentious, whole hearted praise of the Lord. The songs which are chosen are meant to invite worshipers to enter into His presence in spirit and in truth. Various music styles and instruments are used. This gathering focuses on the developed sermon series of our pastors which typically last from three to twelve weeks. The sermon series are designed to be substantial and faith-building, allowing the Word to speak. The avoidance of devotional flimsiness is also evident in the preaching and development of the sermon series. The serving of the Lord's Supper and the receiving of the offering is included. The Gathering for Worship lasts approximately ninety minutes. The small group studies sometimes follow the themes of the preaching series.

You are invited to join us for either or both of our Sunday Worship opportunities. Both worship gatherings are always being critiqued for purposeful improvements.

Children's Church Begins Today and will start when Pastor Bob goes to the pulpit following Praise and Worship. Children's Church will be held in Room 202 and children up to grade 2 are encouraged to come. Lessons and projects based on the Psalms will be taught by Dan Casey.

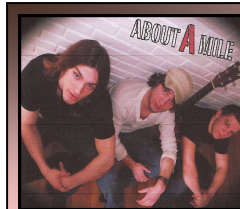
