A S-E-C-U-R-E woman is:

**SAVED** from herself. We are no longer twisted by the idol of self-interest. With the Holy Spirit we are looking upward and outward, not curved in toward self. Pride keeps us self-absorbed; security makes us think of "us" less often.

**ENTITLED** to truth. We no longer walk with emptiness of mind. The more we live withdrawn, the darker our thoughts become. We have put off the old self and been renewed in the spirit of our minds. Don't wait until you feel secure, it begins in the mind. Secure women do not obsess about self all of the time.

**CLOTHED** with intention. We must purposely walk in dignity and security otherwise we will walk in defeat. Christ Jesus is our security. We are a living demonstration of before and after. We get to choose to put off the old and put on the new and then we will fulfill our destinies. God can do anything with anybody. Believe God!

**UPENDED** by Grace. By grace you have been saved. Be kind to one another, tender-hearted, forgiving each other, just as God in Christ also has forgiven you. When we forgive others, the broken become whole, the weak become strong, the poor become rich, the insecure become secure and the impossible becomes possible.

**REBOUNDED** by love. Walk in love just as Christ Jesus loved you. Live as dearly loved children. Life is hard. If a heart does not heal, it hardens. A wounded heart grows callous. God knows you completely and he loves you with measureless love. When we know we are loved, we love. When we know we are forgiven, we forgive. When we receive grace, we give grace.

**EXCEPTIONAL** in life. We matter to God. There is something unique and special about each of us. Put off the old self and put on the new self who is created in righteousness and holiness of the truth. Our before Christ, after Christ transformation will be a living example to those around us.
