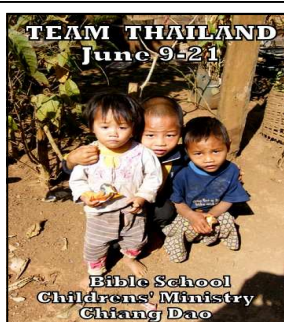
### THE FIGHT FOR PURITY June 2 & 9

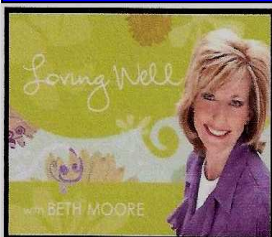
### FREEDOM

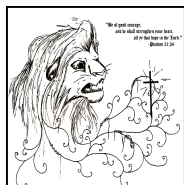
### LADIES BIBLE STUDY— "LOVING WELL" BY BETH MOORE—JUNE 2010

**MEMORIAL DAY** is a United States federal holiday observed on the last Monday of May (May 31 in 2010). First enacted to honor Union soldiers of the American Civil War, it is celebrated near the day of reunification after the Civil War, it was expanded after World War I. Many Americans nowadays have forgotten the meaning and traditions of Memorial Day. Graves of the fallen are increasingly ignored and neglected. Most people no longer remember the proper flag etiquette for the day. While there are towns and cities that still hold Memorial Day parades, many have not held a parade in decades. I have a choice; I can spend the day in bed recounting the difficulty I have with the parts of my body that no longer work, or get out of bed and be thankful for the ones that do. Each day is a gift, and as long as my eyes open, I'll focus on the new day and all the happy memories I've stored away. Just for this time in my life. Old age is like a bank account. You withdraw from what you've put in. So, my advice to you would be to deposit a lot of happiness in the bank account of memories!! Thank you for your part in filling my Memory Bank. I am still depositing."
