On May 31st, Mandy Saeler will fly to Denver to begin the next phase of her Christian walk. She is enrolled in a 10 week training program at Ellerslie. Ellerslie is a ministry of Christian authors, Eric and Leslie Ludy. The program focuses on learning and cultivating a relationship with Christ. Following that 10-week study, Mandy will continue at Ellerslie for the Ellerslie Guided Study Program (EGSP), where "...training will shift from a structured classroom model to a less-formal, individually-governed pursuit of God – but with continued spiritual guidance and discipleship from the Ellerslie leadership."

Mandy's spiritual journey began at the age of six when she accepted the Lord, but really blossomed at NSCC when she became involved in Girls' Bible Study and focused on pursuing a relationship with Jesus Christ. Her decision to go to Ellerslie was greatly influenced by reading <u>Authenic Beauty</u> by Leslie Ludy. When asked what she believes the Lord is calling her to do, she replied, "I believe that God wants to mold in me a feminine life, boldly and joyfully devoted to living for Jesus Christ. It's nearly a year to-the-date that my eyes were opened to the Lord's calling me to Youth Ministry, specifically Girls Ministry."

After Ellerslie, Mandy will be walking in faith, studying diligently, praying faithfully and waiting patiently as HE guides her every step.
