Mike & Joann Noel CMT Missionaries to Tanzania

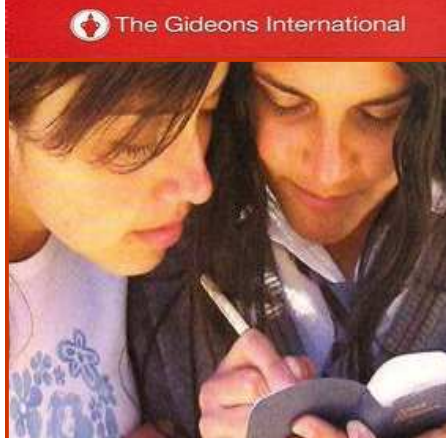

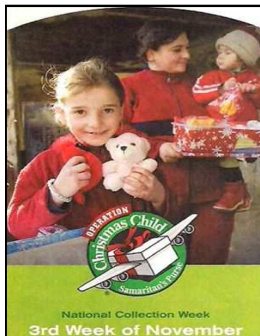

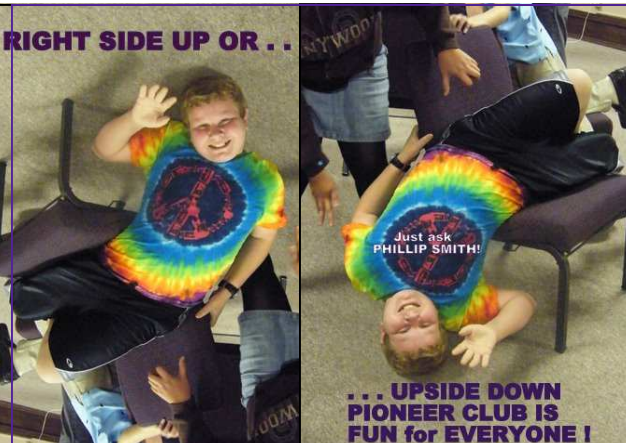
