Phase I - the newly remodeled Christian education/nursery/ dining areas of our building are in full use and have been a great blessing to every area of our ministry.

NSCC Buildings and Property Department recently announced plans to continue progress toward the remodeling and construction of the facilities of North Street Christian Church.

As seen, the Bluff Street House is demolished! (We have video clips too!) Next on the list is to install the acoustic tile ceiling in dining room (sound control) and then do the painting and flooring in the existing stair tower. Moving on from these projects includes remodeling in the existing kitchen and relocation of the offices to the rooms beneath the preschool. At that point, the present office building will be razed. Phase II construction will follow and include a new lobby/entrance with restrooms on two levels and an elevator.

The Building Fund Balance is presently \$19,134.53. Our property team estimates that we can

Building a New Church Building for \$20,000.00 U.S. Nuang Kiew Lahu Village in Northern Thailand



Two years ago a new Church Building was begun in Hui Ko Ahka Village in northern Thailand. That building was dedicated in early 2010 when Dale R., Andy B., and Pastor Bob were there. The photo on the left is of that building.

A similar building is needed in the Nuang Kiew Lahu village. The total cost of the building will be approximately \$20,000.00 (recently increased from previous announcement of \$15,000 - due to rising cost of materials). A fund has been established through our Missions Department and it now has nearly \$2000.00 as a balance!

The Nuang Kiew Church recently hosted

Thanksgiving Worship and a meal for all of those who live in the village and other nearby Trinity Gospel Churches. The other photos are of the Thanksgiving Gathering.

The Nuang Kiew Village Pastor is Chasi. (See bottom photo.) He is faithful to the Lord and to his people. The congregation now has over 280 people and the old Church building only holds about 80 people at a time! The new building will be approximately 1800 sq. ft. and will be full!

You can help build the new building by writing a check to North Street Christian Church and designating it for NUANG KIEW Church. Funds will be distributed in two \$10,000.00 increments. We hope to be able to send the first installment in January or February of 2011. The men of the village, who are farmers, will then have the time to dedicate to the construction of the new building.
