THE HABIT OF EVANGELIZING

Whenever we talk about habits, it is usually about breaking bad ones and not about starting good ones. Evangelizing can become a good habit! Evangelism defined is simply this - telling others about Jesus. Are you in the habit? Following are some things to help get a good habit going. JUST BE YOU - You don't have to put on your evangelism clothes and get a satchel to carry 100 tracts in order to be evangelizing. Since Jesus is important to you and you love Him devotedly and His Word and Spirit are in you, let them be at work through you! MEET THE PERSON AS YOU FIND THEM - Jesus met people just where he found them and met their need as presented. When the Word and Spirit are flowing it is amazing how our words and reasoning flow as we direct people and their circumstances toward Jesus. CONSCIOUSLY BECOME GOD'S PARTNER - While you are prayerfully preparing to share, God is preparing the heart of another person to hear! Where there is a Saul who needs to hear, there is an Ananias being prepared and sent. MAKE EVANGELISM A HABIT - Telling others about Jesus (evangelism) is at the root of all we do as Christ followers. Evangelizing is more than a seminar, a wave of interest, a statistical tool - it really is the way we live! GET INTO THE HABIT - it is more than exciting to see how our faith increases and how God opens doors one after another! PB



Graduation Recognition


