I had asked for money to finish Nong Kiew Church. Evangelist Inson's wife was in the hospital for 3 months but we got started on the work on April 18, 2013. They have been working for 5 days. Some materials we can buy nearby and some we bought from Chiangmai. We thank you so much. We are going to build 2 rooms for men and women and one room for guests.



People in Nong Kiew don't have enough water for use. They are pushing the cart, loaded with water containers to buy the water from other areas. After that, the rain will come and they will drink the rain water from their house roofs. We will use rain water for restroom. If we can plan to store rain water that will be very helpful for mothers and families. Remember them in your prayers.

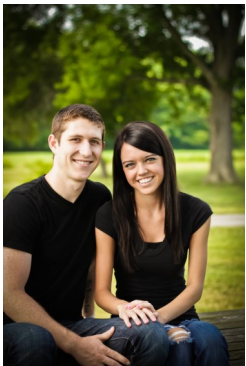
## A CIRCLE OF FRIENDS CONCERT
