IMPROVEMENTS IN OUR AUDITORIUM

The process of installing new carpeting and flooring in the church auditorium, hallways and narthex begins this week! The platform area will be addressed first with the removal of the built-in pulpit and turning the organ console to face the congregation and having it re-installed at a higher level than where it sits presently. The enlarged platform will have two levels. Matching woodwork, to include the present symbols of the Apostles and gold colored shields will be built offsite and installed in order to take advantage of area gained by moving the organ. The entire process will take a few weeks, so expect to see changes in progress each Sunday throughout the month.
