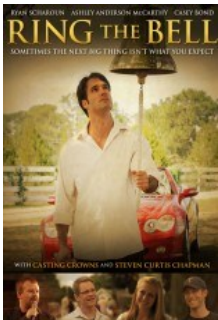
Baptism at Lake Arthur South Shore of Moraine State Park TODAY at 4:00

A Word from Barnabas and Ahta Saengsirikhun**



Ahta his first month support he feed the hungers in Nong Chiew Lahu village. July is a very hard time for hill tribe people especially for Nong Chiew villagers. They have to wait for two more months to harvest season. August we can get some greens including pumpkins and cucumbers.

So Atha used his \$150 bought 3 bags of rice and bought dried noodle packages, and shared them among the hungers.



Another program is sharing prenatal vitamins to poor pregnant mothers. This program will be very helpful for mothers. We should be able doing more than this. God bless you according to his promise. This time I sent Enoch to the northern Thai border. I gave him \$200 dollars-6000 baht. He bought the prenatal vitamins and distributed them. The road is bad enough in raining season. He is walking down to Lisu and Lahu villages. He will be coming back on next week.



Today we went to Lisu Mae Lae village for preaching. Atha drove for us. Atha was using his guitar and led the songs and read Bible verses from Matthew 22:37-39, John 13:34-35, then Ahsipa prayed and I preached.



Tomorrow very early in the morning we will be going to Chiangdao for preaching at Akha village and visit Children ministry as Dengue Fever is spreading around and many kids have to go to hospital.
