OH LORD HOW WE NEED YOU

2013 is already shaping up to be a great year in youth ministry at North Street Christian Church. As I pray for the youth of this church part of my prayer is that God would grab their hearts and they would make their faith their own. That is what this year has been about. We started in Ezekiel and the youth were challenged with no longer being satisfied as a pile of dead dry bones. When I look at our youth I see a group of kids that have a lot of head knowledge but I often think they lack the breath that in the valley brought the corpse back to life. I want breath for the youth of North Street. We then did a convicting series on prayer. We looked at the necessity of communication in any relationship and were convicted by the better job we could be doing in our relationship with our Heavenly Father. We looked at Jesus' outline for prayer as he teaches the disciples to pray. There was extra time spent on the section of "thy kingdom come, thy will be done", we made this our filter for every request we ever ask. We then went to Daniel chapter nine to see a great example of what we had learned in action. As we looked at Daniel 9 and picked apart the prayer of a man of God we learned seven key principles to a successful Godly prayer life.

- Prayer is in response to God's word
- Grounded in God's will
- It is fervent or passionate
- It identifies with God's people
- Built upon confession
- It depends on God's Character
- Its purpose is for God's Glory

JOURNEY OF Faith

Pray for the youth as we head to the book of Ruth, a book that is most likely unread by a lot of you. As we look at the book of Ruth, pray that the youths' eyes would be opened. Pray that they would recognize their need as cursed sinners for a kinsman redeemer and find their refuge under the mighty wings of God.
