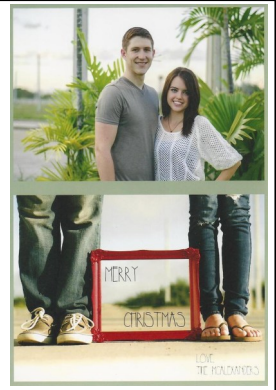
## **ANNUAL CONGREGATIONAL MEETING**
