# OPERATION CHRISTMAS CHILD UPDATE Shoeboxes From NSCC Arrive in Zambia and Lebanon!



Several children from the Wednesday evening Children's Ministry attached their photo to a completed personal information sheet that they put in their gift-filled shoebox. Postage for these particular boxes was paid on-line so Samaritan's Purse tracked them to their overseas destination. I recently received an e-mail that indicated where some of these boxes were shipped. At least one of our Operation Christmas Child shoeboxes was shipped to Zambia and another to Lebanon. ZAMBIA - 242,432 children received an OCC shoebox this year! 22,400 also heard a Bible Lesson. Total shoeboxes to Zambia since 1999 - 1,320,465!

Lebanon - 68,184 children received an OCC shoebox this year! Total shoeboxes to Lebanon since 1995 - 908,675!
