On Sunday morning June 9, here at NSCC, we set aside the day for **Missions, Ministry and Spiritual Growth**. We spent some time hearing from and praying about **World Vision** and the 30 Hour Famine; this week's **Christ in Youth** Conference in Anderson, Indiana where 18 people from NSCC are attending; **Trinity International Missions** with Jesse and Jessy McAlexander; **Trinity Gospel Association** with Barnabas and Martha Saengsirikhun and family (Lisa and Ahta Saengsirikhun were with us here at NSCC); and also for a group of **five short-term missionaries** who headed to Thailand June 11.

While we were here praying in the morning, it was evening (11 hours difference) in Hui Ko Akha village in northern Thailand. Barnabas and Martha and several evangelists had gone there to speak to two families about the Lord.

I will have Barnabas pick up with his own words: *"Last Friday, Akha informed me that 2 families would accept Jesus on Saturday If I could come. We had to wait until Sunday, so after the morning service in Chiang Mai, I was heading Hui Ko Akha village. I called Chaneveh, Zechariah, Insorn, Ahsipa, and Enoch to be met at Akha village. Martha went with me and we left Aunchana to our neighbor's house. When we arrived there, we saw more Akha Christians were gathering there and waiting for me. After dinner we sang and prayed and then the Elder of the Church announced that there will be ELEVEN family will accept Jesus. Then as they leading us, we follow our elder one house after another till eleven house. On small path in the village in the dark they use their torch light shine for us. About 70 people were singing and to house to house. We prayed and cut their sacred cords that fasten on their wrist or necks. Then we destroyed their spirit altars from the wall and put them into big bags and loaded on my truck. We finished our work at 1 am and we drove home. Among the 63 new converts two converts were known as witch doctor (ladies) The first one named Bu Sa were very shaky as we stepped into her house. Now she is pretty weak. I couldn't be silent as we have more new convert. So I went up there and preached I will go there for 3 nights. And I will plan for them to have an evangelist. In this village only within these two months 73 people added to the Church. This happened 8 pm to 1 am on June 9, 2013 about at the same time you were praying for us."*

Let us be praising the Lord for His works amongst His people all over the world!
