## THE AMAZING GRACE RACE!

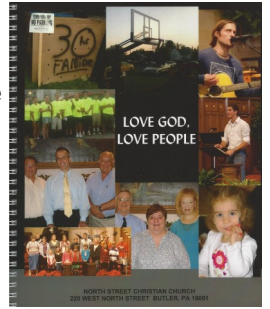

While children and teens are in their Sunday School classes each week, the adults of NSCC are invited and encouraged to choose a Sunday Morning Bible Study Elective. We have four classes to choose from and they are as follows:

**Spiritual Principles from the Book of Samuel** – Join Doug Emmett in Room 101 (Library) beginning Sunday June 2, to learn "Spiritual Principles From the Book of Samuel." The class will be looking in on the lives of Samuel, David, Saul, and others as recorded by the Holy Spirit in God's Word. The same Spirit is invited to open the eyes and lives of each student who takes the class.

**Hebrews Chapter 11** – Join Matt Eckert in room 102 taking a close look at the FAITH HALL OF FAME as recorded in the book of Hebrews and chapter 11. *And without faith it is impossible to please God, because anyone who comes to him must believe that he exists and that he rewards those who earnestly seek him. Hebrews 11:6*

**The "I AM" Statements of Jesus** – Join Jacob Klutinoty as he continues in the Book of John considering the "I AM" sayings of Jesus. You will take in the context, setting, language, and culture of His sayings and be amazed at the depth and breadth of these seemingly simple statements.

**Ecclesiastes** – Join Pastor Bob in the Dining Room (Pulpit Spin Class) considering the futility of life if we only look within and without.
