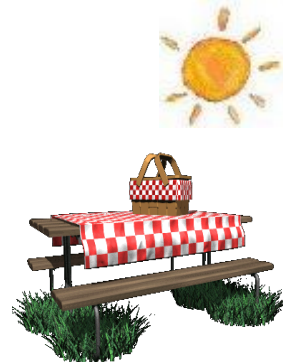
NSCC ANNUAL PICNIC

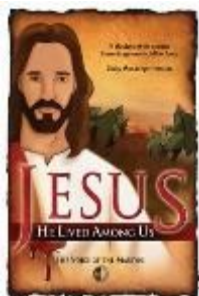


UPCOMING SUMMER MOVIE NIGHTS
