A Word from Pastor Bob The Wonderful Name of Jesus

The name of Jesus is spoken often at North Street Church. The glory, the credit, the homage, the trust in, the salvation promised therein is intentional and it is our natural way of thinking and speaking around this church. We find these words in Acts 4:7-14 . . . By what power or by what name have you done this?" Then Peter, filled with the Holy Spirit, said to them, "Rulers of the people and elders of Israel: If we this day are judged for a good deed done to a helpless man, by what means he has been made well, let it be known to you all, and to all the people of Israel, that by the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth, whom you crucified, whom God raised from the dead, by Him this man stands here before you whole. This is the



'stone which was rejected by you builders, which has become the chief cornerstone.' Nor is there salvation in any other, for there is no other name under heaven given among men by which we must be saved." Now when they saw the boldness of Peter and John, and perceived that they were uneducated and untrained men, they marveled. And they realized that they had been with Jesus.

Pastor Alistair Begg recently wrote, "No one can stand blameless before God on their own merit. There is no escape from sin; from the human pitfalls of jealousy, self-absorption, pride or evil thinking. Sin is woven into our fiber. We are born with an inherent opposition to God and there is no earned, exempt, or intellectual way around our sinful predicament. Salvation is found in Christ and Christ alone. It is this truth that C. S. Lewis emphasizes at the end of The Silver Chair when Jill suggests to Aslan that she must quench her thirst from another stream. The lion responds, "There is no other stream."

O the blessed and wonderful name of Jesus. Pray in His Name. Witness in His Name. Share the testimony of how your life, through the His Name, has been changed forever. Give Him the glory, the credit, the homage that is due! The Name of Jesus - say if often, speak it quietly and shout it from the rooftops! When you have been with Jesus - you can't hide it - they will notice!
