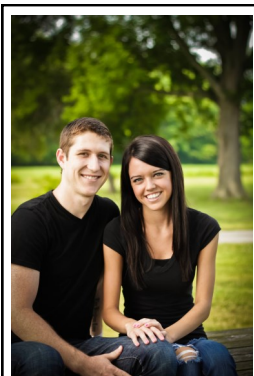


OPPORTUNITIES FOR STUDY AND FELLOWSHIP

N\$CC Kids Church Info Spring 2013

At North Street Christian Church, Kid's Church for Pre-K thru Grade 2 students is held during the 10:15 Gathering for Worship. **Here's how it works** - kids begin their worship experience with their parents in the auditorium for our welcome, meet 'n greet time, and singing as led by the Worship Team. Just before the morning message, we pray and then sing a song. Following that prayer, during the song right before the message, Kid's Church leaders will come to the front of the auditorium. The kids who desire to attend will meet their leaders there. **Dismissal will also be announced via a projected slide** just before the song begins. Once the leaders and kids come forward they will go together to Rooms 303-305 for an age appropriate lesson, followed by a light snack and some fun activities. **Kids can then be picked up by their parents** in Rooms 303-305 at the conclusion of the 10:15 Worship Service.

Kid's Church FAQ's:

What ages are eligible for Kid's Church?

Currently we are offering lessons for Pre-K (at least 4 yrs. old) thru Grade 2.

What will kids be learning?

Kids will be learning basic truths from Bible based lessons.

Where do I take kids that want to attend?

Just bring them with you to the 10:15 Worship Gathering and watch for the Kid's Church leaders who will come forward at the appropriate time to meet and take kids to their classroom. **An announcement slide will also be projected.**

When is Kid's Church over?

Kid's Church will conclude the same time as the Congregational Worship Service. Kid's can be picked up in Rooms 303-305 which is located **upstairs overlooking the nursery.**

What if I need to leave early, Can I get my kids at any time?

Yes. Kids will be in Rooms 303-305 for most of their activities. Check there first; however, **during snack we may be in the dining room or outside weather permitting.**

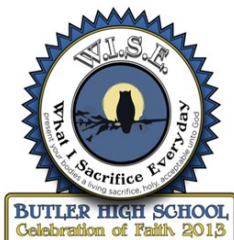
