CHRISTMAS GIFTS FOR LOCAL NEEDY CHILDREN

The Butler City Police Department is working in cooperation with the Butler Salvation Army to provide Christmas gifts for needy children in our community and surrounding area. An **ANGEL TREE** is in the lobby of the Police Station and on that tree are cards detailing items requested by local children. You can stop by the station and pick a card from the tree. The card will indicate the gift which you are to buy and take (unwrapped) to the Police Station by mid-December. The City Police will then deliver the gifts to the Salvation Army who will then distribute the gifts to the needy children of the Butler area.
