The Book of Titus is a short personal letter written by the Apostle Paul to a young leader named Titus. Titus had grown as a "child of the faith" to become used of the Lord as the "Shepherd of Crete." In this twenty-eight sentence letter, Paul through the Holy Spirit, lays out for Titus and the Church at Crete just how a God-glorifying church should be organized, how the people should treat one another and how collectively the church should impact people who are on the outside looking in. The primary message and methodology of the Church is made clear! You are invited to join with us to discover the simplicity and power of God's church from the first century right into the twenty-first century.
