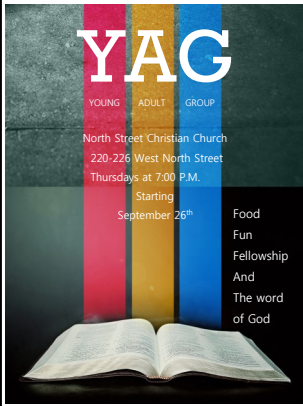
SHOPPING, it is still a good time to get started! LOL) Christmas boxes will be received on Sunday, November 24 – now that's only 84 days away!

### NEW RE-FORMED WEDNESDAY YOUTH GROUP

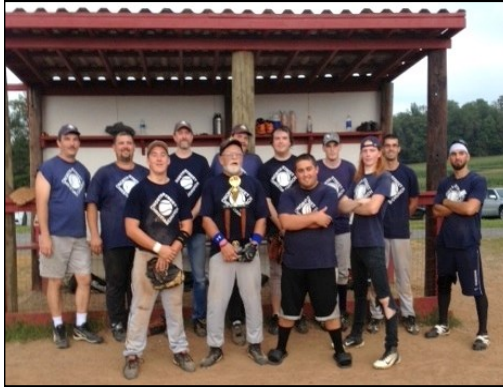
