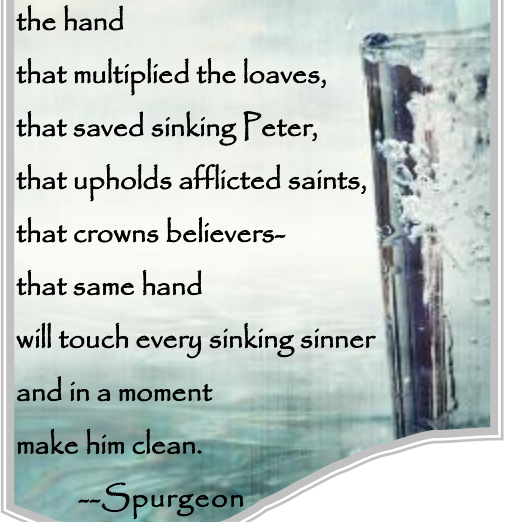


North Street News

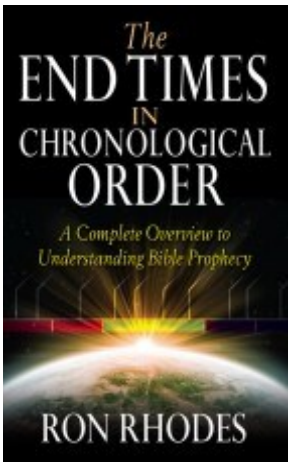


MEN'S STEAK OUT Friday Night at the Fights October 4 at 6:00

End Times In Chronological Order



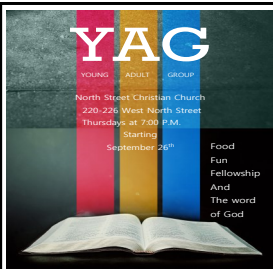

SR CITIZEN NEWS Oil Creek and Titusville Railroad Trip Thursday, October 17

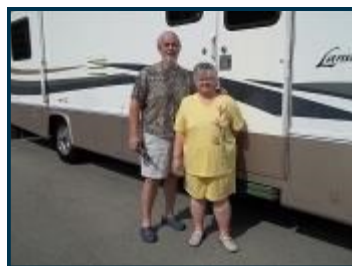
