Our time in the states, although busy, was super encouraging and successful. Many people jumped on board and pledged to get involved with the work in Thailand. We are so excited that during our trip in the states, we were able to get 12 new child sponsors for the kids at the Children's Ministry! We now have 27 children sponsored, with 3 currently in the processing stage. We've nearly doubled the number of sponsored kids and it's really exciting! At the same time, we are still looking for sponsors for all of the remaining kids. We see the blessing that sponsors are to the kids and vice versa, and it's such a joy to be involved with it all!

In other news...We're thrilled that money is being raised to provide the kids at the Children's Ministry with their very own Bibles. As many of you know, these newly released Bibles have the most accurate translation to date! As we returned back to Thailand, a need presented itself right away...Now that the kids have new translations, what about Enoch, who leads the kids' church each Sunday? We saw the need to buy him a new Bible in the same translation as the kids' Bibles, not only so he could have an updated version, but so all the kids could easily follow along during the service. We were able to purchase a Bible for him that is in both Thai and English.
