SUNDAY SCHOOL BEGINS AT 9:00

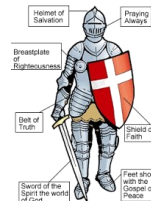

Congregational Meeting Report

On Sunday, January 26, NSCC held the Annual Congregational Meeting to approve the budget and new leaders for 2014. Over 80 people were in attendance - which is above average for this meeting and especially remarkable with such arctic temperatures.

The 2014 Budget of \$295,633.73 was approved as presented by John McIntyre. Offering income is budgeted at \$207,000.00. Trust income is budgeted at nearly \$78,000.00. Departmental income is budgeted at \$11,000.00. Of course this does not include our income or giving to missions. 15% of regular offerings plus designated gifts comprise our Missions Budget. In 2013, NSCC gave just over \$100,000.00 to missions.

The congregation approved five Elders to begin/renew a term of three years. NSCC Shepherd/Overseers now serving are Andy Bilowich, Terry Hartman, Bob Huber, John McIntyre, Dennis Muir, Bob Ogden, George Rader, Jon Ray and Gary Saeler. Pastors are Bob Huber and Jake Klutinoty.

Dennis Muir led a discussion concerning building and improvements for the future. A survey form was distributed and a report of the results will soon be available.
