Dr. Yarbrough will preach a message entitled **Your Choice: Gate One or Gate Two** from Matthew 7:13,14. ## Community Outreach Day Saturday March 15 at 2:30

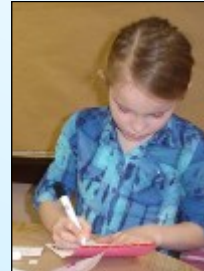

On Sunday January 26 at our Annual Congregational Meeting we passed out a survey gaining input from the congregation concerning campus and facility improvements at NSCC. Upon analyzing the 33 surveys which were returned, the order of improvements were ranked as following:

1. Lift/Elevator
2. Improved Offices
3. New Fellowship Hall/Kitchen
4. Improved/Additional Restrooms
5. New Larger Lobby

Our leadership has taken on the task of working toward meeting these needs. Presently, the goal is to work toward the addition of handicapped accessibility and improved offices, using funds we presently have in hand along with some additional funds to be raised. Our goal includes some remodeling to include a Men's Restroom on the main auditorium level. Sizeable funding will be necessary to complete a new fellowship hall and new lobby in the future.
