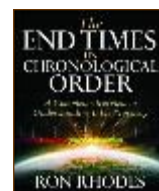
Mondays at 10:00 a.m.

THE CALLED OUT ONES

Pastor Bob is always excited to preach about the message and mission of the Church. The Bible word translated "church" is *ekklesia*. The word comes from two words - 'ek' meaning 'out' and 'kaleo' meaning to 'call.' In classical Greek "ekklesia" meant an assembly of citizens summoned by a crier for an authoritative purpose.
